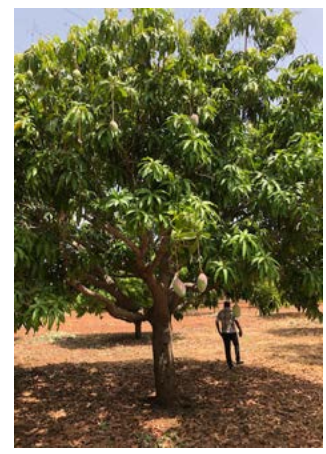

Mango is sourced from smallholders that dry the fruit themselves before delivering it to our producers for quality control, metal detection and packaging. All farmers benefit from organic prices for their products. The economic activities from mango generate income for thousands of families in Burkina Faso, which is one of the poorest countries in the world. Our suppliers invest in the local communities they operate in by contributing to community health centres and supplying materials and seedlings to smallholders.

Established in 1980, our producer has a rich history in the production and export of fresh and dried mango. Per day, 850 kg of mango gets cut, depitted and sliced per hand by 144 production workers. Located in the north of Ivory Coast, the mango plantation spans across 1200 ha, including 350 ha of organic production. Quality is controlled from planting to final packaging, ensuring the fruit is free from additives or preservatives to deliver exceptional quality and taste.

Our supplier creates substantial added value to the crops of the farmers and provides jobs for the local population, specifically focussing on employing women in the region to help enhance their general status and lifestyle. The supplier assists the smallholders they work with by providing relevant knowledge and guaranteeing the purchasing of their harvest. This is important to ensure a steady income for the farmers, who represent a vital component in the production chain.
